To do a Career Interest Inventory:

Click on K-12 Student (picture of the red cardinal at end of 1st row)
Click on Explore It
Click on Career Cluster Inventory
Click on Get Started
Click on Start
Complete the 80 Interest questions
Click on get Scores
Click on Save or Click on Retake-then Save
PRINT

To Explore Careers:

After you take the Career Cluster Inventory, Click on Career Cluster in blue to get specifics about careers. Click on Careers that interest you. PRINT the ones you want to explore.

Click on Occupational Search (black colored icon of a running light bulb in the 2nd row)

Select an Industry from the drop down menu in Industry Search or type in a job under keyword Search such as, video game designer or preschool teacher.

Click on Go

Click on specific occupations within that career area and explore for more information.

PRINT the ones you find most interesting to you.

To Explore Colleges and Postsecondary Training related to specific careers:

After you take the Career Interest Inventory and select some careers of interest, click on Education and Training Opportunities for specific colleges and schools that you could attend.
